PARADE RULES

The City of Cleveland will provide a Santa Claus for the parade, so please refrain from including a Santa Claus on your float if at all possible, Thank You!

What is considered a Float?

A float can be a creative design and/or construction that is placed on wheels and pulled by a car, truck horse, mule or even a person. A float is not a decorated vehicle unless a trailer is pulled by the vehicle. All decorated vehicles are encouraged to participate; however they will not be judged as floats. Antique vehicles, to include vintage vehicles or collector cars and motorcycles of all types are welcome and add a great deal to the parade.

What is the difference between Commercial and Non-Commercial Floats?

The difference between Commercial and Non-Commercial Floats is that a **Commercial Float** is a business that has decorated their float and **Non-Commercial Float** would be churches, schools, individuals and organizations.

Commercial Floats and Non-Commercial Floats Labeling Requirements

Lettering must be large enough to read from the reviewing stand. It must state the sponsor's name. The labeling must be placed on the right side (facing the front of the float). You will be assigned a number at the line up on the day of the parade. A large number will be placed on the front of the float or pulling vehicle for the benefit of the announcer. Use a (3x5) index card, in 25 words or less and describe your float/entry, and attach it to the entry form. This will be used by the announcer from the reviewing stand and must be received by Friday, November 16 deadline date.

The Day of the Parade

You must line up between 4:30 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. beside the Sanctuary Church along Travis Street. **PLEASE BE ON TIME.** Judging will start at 5:00 p.m., if you are not in line by 5 p.m. your float will not be considered. Winners will be announced during the parade. Judging will be based on the most original expression of Christmas in Commercial Float and Non-Commercial Float categories. **Please light** your float so that it may be seen and make this a festive event.

FOR SAFETY REASONS: NO CANDY OR OTHER ITEMS WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE THROWN FROM ANY FLOAT AS IT WILL BE DARK.
