

DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland, Liberty, San Jacinto and Montgomery County, Texas on or about the 19th day of September 2019 has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from heavy rainfall, severe flooding and possible tropical storm force winds from Tropical Storm Imelda; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Cleveland, located in Liberty, San Jacinto and Montgomery Counties, Texas has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property; now, therefore,

BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND, TEXAS

Section 1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared in the City of Cleveland, located in Liberty, San Jacinto and Montgomery Counties, Texas pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

Section 2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Cleveland, Liberty and Montgomery County, Texas.

Section 3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

Section 4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the City of Cleveland, located in Liberty, San Jacinto and Montgomery Counties, Texas emergency management plan.

Section 5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.


