


1. Roll Call. Chuck Thompson absent

3. Tommy Ramsey spoke of the Charter Home Rule being your governing document of city laws. Charter review commission is used in the process for amending the city's Charter which the city can amend the charter either by a petition from the citizens or the City Council can propose an amendment. Tommy Ramsey spoke on deciding how process the review of Charter Home Rule whether it be breaking it up or doing it all in one day. Danny Lee asked if anything needed to be added to Charter Rule it could be put on the November ballot. Tommy Ramsey spoke of deadline to order an election for November election is mid-August. Recommends to target the May election. Scott Swigert spoke of things being in the current Charter that are no longer permitted by the state law and that those are the types of things to clean up.
