Tom R with VIK Architects spoke about the project. Discussion occurred regarding the new school blvd to go through to US 59 to help alleviate traffic issues on FM 2025 and keep off Birch. Discussion about Birch Street occurred. The extra parking areas at the school will help keep the queue off FM 2025. The programming for each type of building will be the same so that helps with future build outs. There will also be chargeable stations in each room. CISD is looking to bring to City Council in April/May a final plat for approval. There are a couple months of burning brushes left. City Manager Pennington spoke on the water project needs for this area. VIK Architects mentioned that they need to be under construction on the school building by June 2021 to meet their scheduling deadline.


Adjourn
